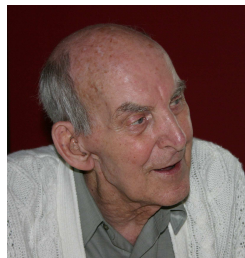
It is by choice that I choose to work one on one with people.
